

2008 Fall Pack 478 Hike

- When:** Saturday, November 15th, 2008
- Where:** Picacho Peak State Park
Hunter Trail off the Barrett Loop
- Who:** All Pack 478 Cub Scouts, siblings, family members and friends are welcome!
- Bring:** Cash to pay for parking (\$6), plenty of water, hiking shoes (no sandals), sun-block, hat, camera, band aids, jacket, snacks, etc.
- Food:** Pack Sponsored BBQ hot dog and burger lunch at the conclusion of the hike! (bring your own snacks for on the hike)



- Meet:** ****Lagos Elementary School at 8:15am** if you want to caravan / carpool
Leave Lagos promptly at 8:30am
Hike starts promptly at 10:00am at Picacho Peak
- About:** Beautiful hike!! Base is 2,000 feet. Summit is 3,300 feet. Will likely take saddle side hike. Saddle hike is 2 miles round trip and will take approximately 1.5-2 hours. If we decide to go to the summit, it is 4 miles and approximately 4 hours (unlikely). Parking is \$6 per vehicle. Lunch will be cooked and served at the conclusion of the hike. It will be bbq hot dogs, burgers, drinks and other goodies. Temperature will likely be in the high 70's to 80. Bring a jacket just in case!
- Directions:** Head east on I-10 toward Tucson for 64 mi. Take exit 219 for Picacho Peak Rd. for .2 mi. turn right @ Picacho Peak Rd. for .5 mi to the fee station/gate (there is some construction) from there we'll go about a .25mi to the Barrett Loop turn off (last chance to use the restroom) take a left and park right at the trail head/Saguaro ramada. Saguaro ramada will be where we grill lunch. The drive should be right around one hour, give or take a couple minutes.
