FYI:

- There are stores only a few miles away in Prescott
- The campsite has bathrooms
- Pack 478 reserved the “Group Area” for Friday, Saturday and Sunday evenings

Directions: Take I-17 to Highway/Junction 69 (west bound) to Prescott, take Sheldon street (highway 89) to Montezuma, turn right at stop light, follow road (turns into Iron Springs road) for three miles, turn into Forest road 374 and travel 4 miles to Granite Basin group camp. **HERE IS ANOTHER SET OF DIRECTIONS;** To reach Granite Basin Lake from the Courthouse in downtown Prescott, take Montezuma Street north. Montezuma will become Whipple Street, and Whipple will become Iron Springs Road. Follow Iron Springs Road to Forest Road 374. Follow it for about 4 miles to the lake.

Elevation: 5,600 feet – 5 acres - **Fishing:** License required for those over 14 - **Boating:** Electric motors only (1 HP or less)
