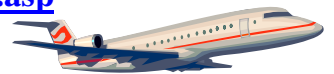


• Friday:

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's):



Bathrooms: Yes, there are bathrooms and HOT showers!!!! Nice!!!

Temperature: Day = 80 degrees / Night = 50 degrees - - - [Click here for weekend weather in Payson](#)

Trailers: NOT ALLOWED – except for three previously approved for special needs (Cook, Foreman, Dugan).

Food: Pack sponsored Saturday BBQ Chicken Dinner w/ sides. Bring or buy your other food (stores < 5 miles)

Campfire: Everyone must come prepared with at LEAST one skit, song, joke or story to SHARE please

Flying: Every child, Cub Scout or not, will be allowed to fly with Young Eagles **WITH PERMISSION SLIP!**

Geocache: We will do a Geocache if time and location permit on Sunday – Bring your GPS if you have it!!

Pets: NOT ALLOWED – too dangerous around airplanes

Distance: Approximately 1.5 hours from Ahwatukee

Small Children: Use your best judgment and be an attentive parent. This is a working airport with airplanes.

Arrival Time: Whenever you would like. Many like Friday night to maximize Sat. But, Sat. arrival is fine too.

Geocache: BRING SMALL TOYS to leave or you CANNOT TAKE ONE when cache is found = sad children!

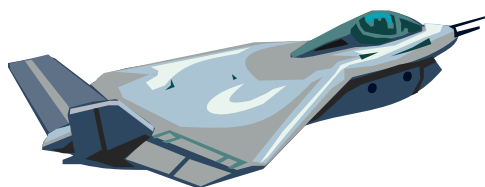
806 West Airport Road

1. Take I-10 West
2. Take exit 154 to merge onto US-60 E toward Globe/Mesa - 4.2 mi
3. Take exit 176B for Hwy 101 N - 0.6 mi
4. Merge onto AZ-101 N - 2.7 mi
5. Take exit 51 for State Hwy 202 E - 1.1 mi
6. Merge onto AZ-202 E - 2.5 mi
7. Take exit 13 for Country Club Dr/State Hwy 87 toward Payson - 0.3 mi
8. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for AZ-87 S and merge onto AZ-87/N Country Club Dr - 0.2 mi
9. Turn left to stay on AZ-87/N Country Club Dr - Continue to follow AZ-87 - 75.0 mi
10. Turn left at W Airline Rd/W Airport Rd - 1.0 mi (a mile or so past the McDonalds and Wal-Mart)

***** **LOOK** for the signs that say Welcome Cub Scouts.

***** The gate must be unlocked and you will be let in.

***** The gate must be locked behind you.
