From Phoenix head north on I-17. There are two ways to get there... You can go through Williams, AZ. or Flagstaff, AZ

Total drive time will be about 3.5 to 4hrs.

- Located 4 1/2 miles south of Grand Canyon National Park, on the east side of State Highway 64, and 2 miles south of Tusayan, AZ.
- From Flagstaff, AZ: take Hwy. 180 north to Hwy. 64 north.

- From Williams, AZ: take Hwy. 64 north.

Everyone attending the overnight events will need to review and sign the permission slip and Medical release forms.

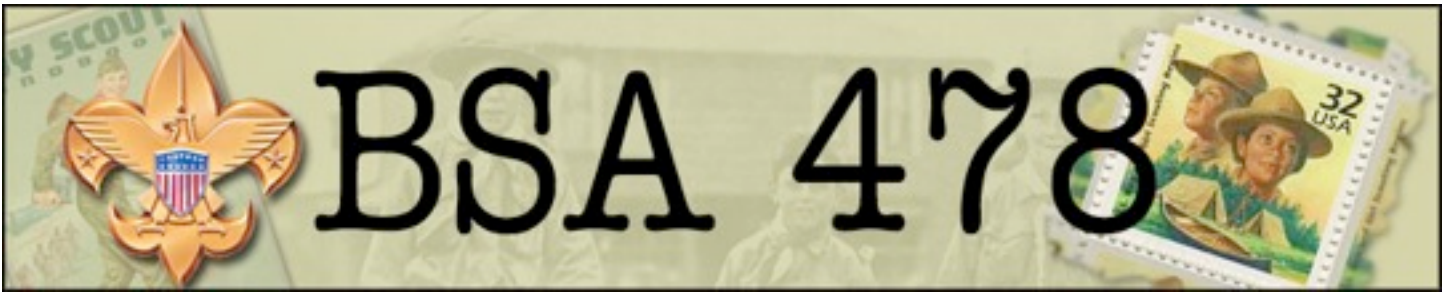
### Important notes and reminders:

**Ten-X campground is just a couple of miles south of Tusayan, AZ. There is a small convenience store and other small town amenities available.**



The group site accommodates Rv's w/ pull throughs and backups (No electric hook ups). There are numerous tent sites around the

area with BBQ grills and Campfire rings. The main site offers a picnic pavilion w/ tables, potable water, toilets and trash bins.



## **Things to remember:**

The elevation is at 6,500 ft so it will be cooler in the day (60-85) and down right chilly (40-50) at night. Please bring appropriate clothing for all types of weather. It could rain or even snow (unlikely, but not out of the realm of possibility) up at the South Rim this time of year.

As always please remember to bring all the things one might need when they camp overnight:

Camping gear: Tents, bags, lights, chairs, etc....

Fun ideas, games, jokes, stories and skits....(the more the better)

Firewood and more firewood.....did I mention firewood!

Sunscreen lotion

Food and water(the pack is only providing one meal)

We are very close to the Grand Canyon. This will be a great opportunity to visit the Canyon. The park entry fee to the Grand Canyon is \$25.00 per car and is good for 7 days.
